The Challenge Why Climate Finance Matters

- Economies still dependent on unsustainable industries
- Eco-enterprises struggle to access finance to scale
- Vulnerable communities risk being left behind without inclusive finance


Across multiple leading reports (CPI, UNFCCC, IEA), the consensus is that only about 30% of the needed climate finance is currently available, resulting in a ~70% global financing gap for eco-projects and green transition efforts.
